CALL TO CONFESSION

Confession is a spiritual discipline that leads us into a deeper relationship with the Holy. As we approach God in community in Confession, we open our hearts to the hearing of God's word.

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

Most wise and loving God, you are the one sure Source of grace, mercy and peace. Thank you for not allowing us to get by with shallow penitence. Thank you for requiring us to look deeply in ourselves and offer deep repentance. There is much in the things we do and say, to give us regret. We abandon ourselves to whatever discipline and painful therapy may be needed if we are to mend our ways. (*Pause*)

Most wonderful God, may your saving love never cease to amaze us, your forgiveness never fail to touch the shameful corners of our heart and mind, and your empowerment always be our hope and our joy. Through Christ Jesus our Savior.
