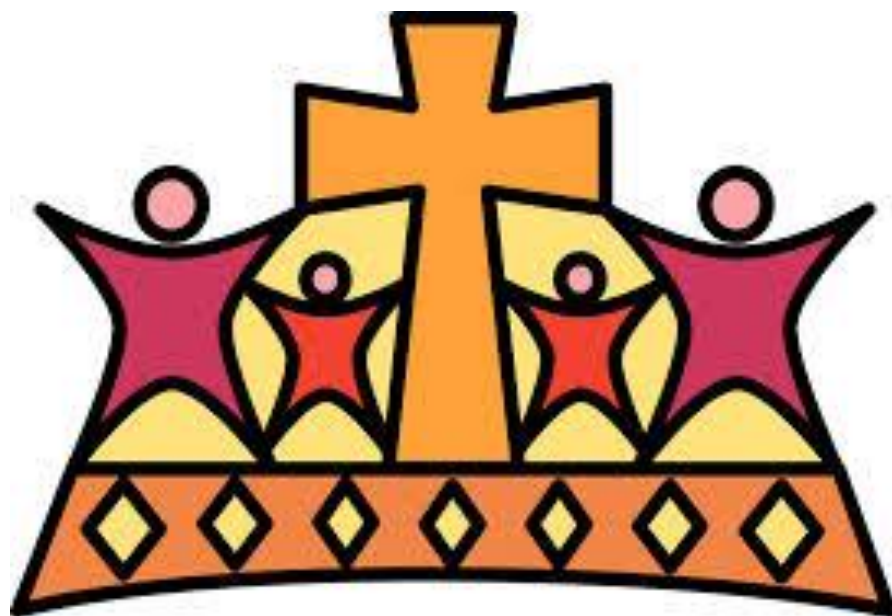
The UMW Cookie Walk is Saturday Dec 5th.
