The Edgerton United Methodist Church has established the Phil Tucker Scholarship as an encouragement to our youth to continue their education in the field of Wildlife Management or Natural Resources. The scholarship was made possible by a gift from Phil Tucker in 2015.

1. The scholarship shall be in an amount to be determined by the Memorial Committee.
2. The Memorial Committee will make the selection on qualified candidates.
3. The scholarship will be awarded to as many candidates as there are funds to support.
4. The scholarship will be awarded on an annual basis.
5. Candidates must have completed one full semester of college in the Wildlife Management or Natural Resources field.
6. Candidates must be active members of Edgerton United Methodist Church.
7. Candidates must submit an application to the Memorial Committee by the announced deadline each year.
8. A certificate of award will be presented during worship on a designated day, usually the second Sunday in January. The scholarship money is awarded at midyear, for use in the second half of the school year.
9. The recipients may select their own school offering a degree in either of the above fields.
